BACKGROUND

The Denver Day Reporting Center (DRC) opened in 1991 to provide reentry services for individuals transitioning back to the community. The Denver DRC serves pre-trial, county, and district offenders from the state and several counties in Colorado. The DRC also partners with the Office of Behavioral Health to provide the Recovery in a Safe environment (RISE) program at the Denver County Jail and Denver Sobriety Court.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Denver DRC, operated by GEO Reentry Services, offers cognitive behavioral programming, drug testing, and electronic monitoring services to provide a continuum of intensive supervision. The DRC provides assigned parolees and probationers with evidence-based programs and services to assist with long-term behavior change with the objective to reduce recidivism and increase public safety.

The Denver DRC offers services for urinalysis, breathalyzer, oral swab, and hair follicle testing. Electronic Monitoring (EM) is also provided as a sentencing option for state jurisdictions. Colorado Department of Corrections (DOC) parolees may have electronic monitoring equipment installed or deinstalled at the DRC. In addition, the office offers specific services for Health and Human Services and private agencies as requested.

FACILITY DESCRIPTION

The Denver DRC is located in downtown Denver near the probation and parole offices, the jail, courthouse and other community resources for those who need assistance after release from incarceration. The office is easily accessible by bus, car, or light rail.

The Denver DRC is certified to run treatment groups including OSAT, a program that combines clean and sober outdoor activities with addiction recovery.
