BACKGROUND

Tooley Hall is a residential community corrections program for offenders referred through the Denver Community Corrections Board. The center provides services to prepare residents for a successful transition to the community and to reduce recidivism in the Denver area.

Tooley Hall maintains several unique partnerships to help residents build pro-social ties to the community.



PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Residents participate in the EMBARC (Enhancing Motivation by Achieving Reshaped Cognition) program, created in equal partnership with the Division of Criminal Justice (DCJ) and DDCC. EMBARC is a specialized treatment program that provides evidence-based Cognitive Behavioral Treatment (CBT) to change thinking and behavior.



EMBARC utilizes the Cognitive Behavioral Interventions – a Comprehensive Curriculum (CBI-CC) treatment model developed by Dr. Edward Latessa, University of Cincinnati. The 90-day research-informed model uses strategies and techniques to work with high-risk offenders. EMBARC targets the top four criminogenic needs including antisocial thinking, antisocial companions, antisocial personality/temperament, and impulse control deficits. Residents are required to participate in a minimum of 250 hours of CBT prior to discharge from the program.

GEO Reentry’s residential programs deliver temporary housing, monitoring, and transitional services for adult male and female reentrants nationwide. These community-based solutions support federal and state correctional agencies work in a safe and secure residential setting as an alternative to custody or as a step-down from incarceration as reentrants return to community life.

FACILITY DESCRIPTION

Tooley Hall is located in the northeast Park Hill neighborhood of Denver. Security is maintained by cameras, fencing, gates and emergency exits.
